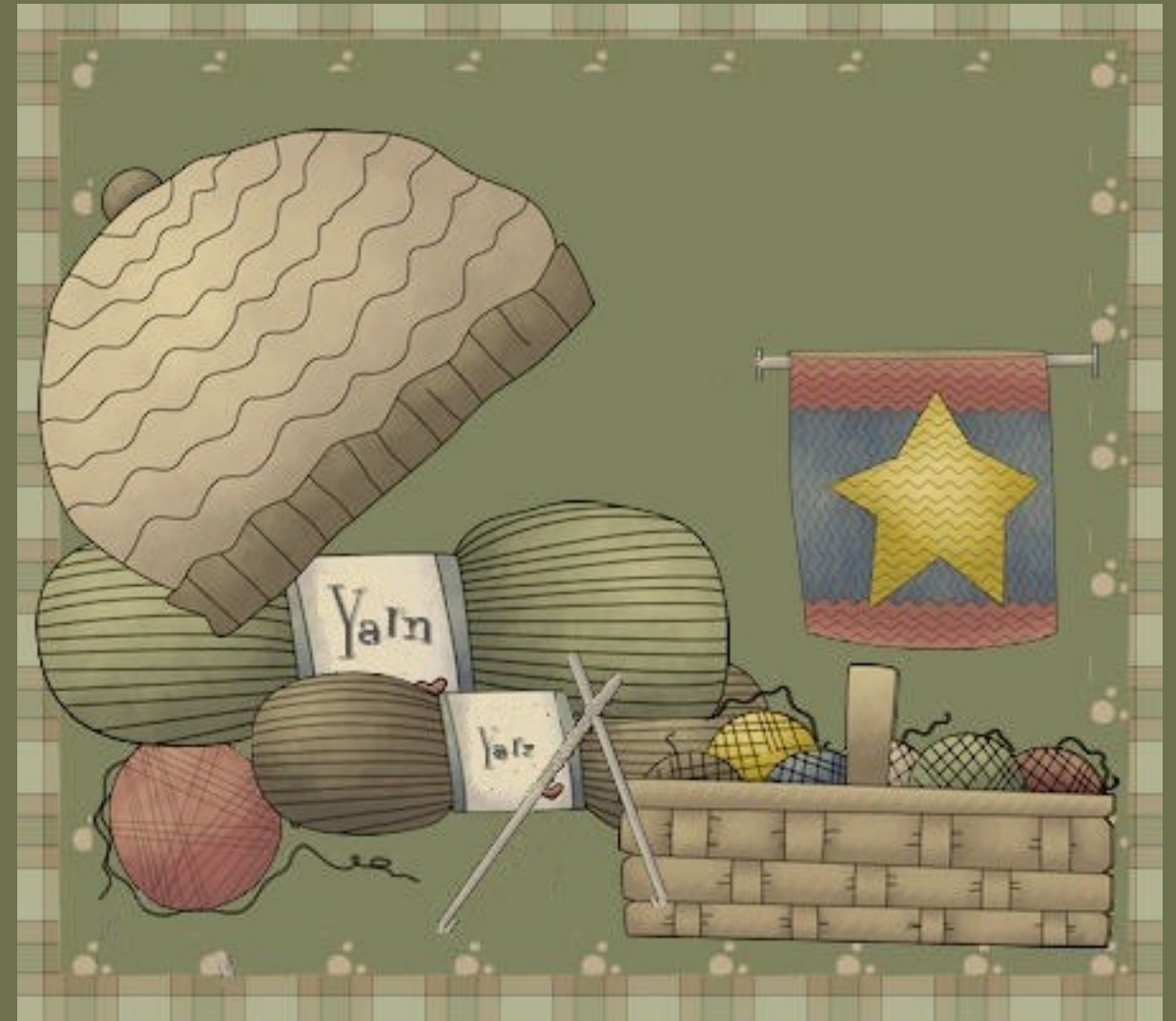


# St. Patrick's Day



# Shamrock Fridgie or Jewelry



## SHAMROCK FRIDGIE OR JEWELRY

Designed by Priscilla Hewitt  
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*The yarn shamrock works well as a fridgie or pin or tack one in the corner of an Aran Afghan as a gift for an Irish friend! The small thread shamrock would make a nice scatter pin, earrings or even a tie tac.*



### Materials:

- Green worsted weight yarn and crochet hook size F or green size 10 thread and crochet hook size 8
- Magnet or jewelry finding

### Finished size:

Yarn - about 2 1/2" across widest point

Thread - a little less than 1" across widest point

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Ch 4, join with a sl st to form ring.

**Round 1:** (Sc in ring, ch 4, sl st in the 4th ch from hook to form picot) 3 times, sc in ring; ch 8, insert hook in the 2nd ch from hook and draw up a loop, (insert hook in the next ch and draw up a loop) 2 times, yo and pull through all 4 remaining loops on hook, sl st in each of the next 4 ch's; join with a sl st to the first sc.

**Round 2:** \*Sl st into the next picot, ch 2, (3 dc, sc, 3 dc, ch 2, sl st) all in the same picot, sl st in the next sc\* Repeat from \* to \* 2 times. Fasten off. Weave in ends.

**Finishing:** Glue or sew magnet or jewelry finding to the back.



# Shamrock Potholder



## SHAMROCK POTHOLDER

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### Materials:

- Green worsted weight cotton yarn
- Crochet hook size G
- Yarn needle

**Gauge:** Rounds 1-4 = about 4"

**Finished size:** About 6½" across

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### *Front*

Ch 4, join with a sl st in the first ch to form a ring.

**Round 1:** Work 2 sc in the ring, (ch 3, sc in the 2nd ch from hook, sc in the next ch, sc in the ring) 3 times; join with a sl st in the first sc. (You should have 3 "branches")

**Round 2:** Sl st in the next sc, \*(sc in the base of the first foundation ch of the next branch, hdc in the next foundation ch of the same branch, 5 dc in the bar at the tip of the branch, working along the other side of the same branch, hdc in the next sc, sc in the next sc) sl st in the next sc that's worked in the ring\* Repeat from \* to \* 2 times; do not join.

**Round 3:** Sl st in each of the next 2 sl st's, \*skip next sc, sc in the next hdc, 2 dc in each of the next 2 dc, sc in the next dc, 2 dc in each of the next 2 dc, sc in the next hdc, skip next sc, sl st in the next sl st\* Repeat from \* to \* 2 times; do not join.

**Round 4:** Sl st in each of the next 2 sl st's, \*skip next sc, sc in the next dc, 2 dc in each of the next 3 dc, sc in the next sc, 2 dc in each of the next 3 dc, sc in the next dc, skip the next sc, sl st in the next sl st.\* Repeat from \* to \* 2 times; do not join.

**Round 5:** Sl st in each of the next 2 sl st's, \*skip next sc, sc in the next dc, hdc in the next dc, 2 dc in each of the next 3 dc, (dc, hdc) in the next dc, sc in the next sc, (hdc, dc) in the next dc, 2 dc in each of the next 3 dc, hdc in the next dc, sc in the next dc, skip the next sc, sl st in the next sl st.\* Repeat from \* to \* 2 times; do not join.

**Round 6:** Sl st in each of the next 2 sl st's, \*skip next sc, sc in the next hdc, hdc in the next dc, dc in the next dc, 2 dc in each of the next 4 dc, (dc, hdc) in the next dc, sc in the next hdc, sl st in the next sc, sc in the next hdc, (hdc, dc) in the next dc, 2 dc in each of the next 4 dc, dc in the next dc, hdc in the next dc, sc in the next hdc, skip the next sc, sl st in the next sl st.\* Repeat from \* to \* 2 times; do not join.

**Stem:** Ch 13, yo insert hook in the 4th ch from hook and pull up a loop, yo and pull through 2 loops on hook, (yo insert hook in the next ch and pull up a loop, yo and pull through 2 loops on hook) 2 times, yo and pull through all 4 remaining

loops on hook, (yo, insert hook in next ch and pull up a loop) 2 times, yo and pull through all 5 remaining loops on hook, hdc in each of the remaining 5 ch's, skip next sl st on the shamrock; join with a sl st to the next sl st. Fasten off.

### *Back*

Work as for the front through round 6.

**Stem:** Ch 10, work 3 dc in the 4th ch from hook, 2 hdc in the next ch, hdc in each of the remaining 5 ch's, skip next sl st on the shamrock; join with a sl st to the next sl st. Fasten off.

### *Assembly*

With wrong sides together, sc front and back together around the perimeter of the shamrock, then sl st together front and back of the stem. Thread yarn needle with yarn, sew front and back together along the sl st's between the petals to prevent the potholder from separating. Weave in all ends.
