

Belt Pouches



BELT POUCHES

Designed by Priscilla Hewitt
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Materials for 2 pouches:

- About 2 ounces of Red Heart Super Saver Camouflage yarn (or any color you like)
 - Crochet hook size G (5.99 mm)
 - Large yarn needle
 - Large safety pin
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Large Pouch

Ch 16.

Row 1: Sc in the 2nd ch from hook and in each remaining ch across; ch 1, turn. (15 sc)

Rows 2-14: Sc in each sc across; ch 1, turn. (15 sc) Mark row 14 with the safety pin.

Rows 15-49: Sc in each sc across; ch 1, turn.

Row 50: Sc in each sc across. Fasten off.

Small Pouch

Ch 11.

Row 1: Sc in the 2nd ch from hook and in each remaining ch across; ch 1, turn. (10 sc)

Rows 2-14: Sc in each sc across; ch 1, turn. (10 sc) Mark row 14 with the safety pin.

Rows 15-49: Sc in each sc across; ch 1, turn.

Row 50: Sc in each sc across. Fasten off.

Finishing

1. Thread needle with 15" of yarn. Fold row 1 over to meet row 14 (marked with a safety pin.) Sew row 1 to row 14 across all the sc to form the belt loop.
2. Thread the needle with 15" of yarn. Fold row 50 up to meet row 14 on the other side from the belt loop. Sew the ends of the rows together to form a pocket. Weave in all ends.
