



## **Granny Square Potholder Pocket & Gift Set**

Designed by Priscilla Hewitt  
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*Use this granny square or your favorite 6" square! Works like a thumb-less oven mitt!*

*Insert a purchased lightweight dishtowel and/or dishcloth into the pocket for a gift.*

Materials: Worsted weight cotton yarn, about 3 ounces of color A, about 1 ounce color B,,  
crochet hook G (4.00 mm) or size needed to achieve gauge, pins, ¾" bone ring

Gauge: Rounds 1-3 of front= 3 ¼"across  
Finished size: 6 ½" wide x 7 ¾" long (adjustable)

Front: Use this granny square or your favorite 6" square!

With color A, ch 5; join with a sl st in the first ch to form a ring

Round 1: Ch 3 to count as the first dc, work 2 more dc in the ring, ch 3, (3 dc in the ring, ch 3) 3 times; join with a sl st in the top of the beginning ch 3. (12 dc) Fasten off color A.

Round 2: Attach color B with a sl st in any ch-3 sp, ch 3 to count as the first dc, work 2 more dc in the same ch-3 sp, ch 1, \*(3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc, ch 1) in the next ch-3 sp\* Repeat

from \* to \* 2 times, 3 dc in the same ch-3 sp as the first dc, ch 3; join with a sl st in the top of the beginning ch 3. (24 dc) Fasten off color B.

Round 3: Attach color A with a sl st in any ch-3 sp, ch 3 to count as the first dc, work 2 more dc in the same ch-3 sp, ch 1, 3 dc in the next ch-1 sp, ch 1, \*(3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc, ch 1) in the next ch-3 sp, 3 dc in the next ch-1 sp, ch 1\* Repeat from \* to \* 2 times, 3 dc in the same ch-3 sp as the first dc, ch 3; join with a sl st in the top of the beginning ch 3. (36 dc) Fasten off color A.

Round 4: Attach color B with a sl st in any ch-3 sp, ch 3 to count as the first dc, work 2 more dc in the same ch-3 sp, ch 1, (3 dc in the next ch-1 sp, ch 1) 2 times, \*(3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc, ch 1) in the next ch-3 sp, (3 dc in the next ch-1 sp, ch 1) 2 times\* Repeat from \* to \* 2 times, 3 dc in the same ch-3 sp as the first dc, ch 3; join with a sl st in the top of the beginning ch 3. (48 dc) Fasten off color B.

Round 5: Attach color A with a sl st in any ch-3 sp, ch 3 to count as the first dc, work 2 more dc in the same ch-3 sp, ch 1, (3 dc in the next ch-1 sp, ch 1) 3 times, \*(3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc, ch 1) in the next ch-3 sp, (3 dc in the next ch-1 sp, ch 1) 3 times\* Repeat from \* to \* 2 times, 3 dc in the same ch-3 sp as the first dc, ch 3; join with a sl st in the top of the beginning ch 3. (60 dc) Fasten off color A.

Round 6: Attach color B with a sl st in any ch-3 sp, ch 3 to count as the first dc, work 2 more dc in the same ch-3 sp, ch 1, (3 dc in the next ch-1 sp, ch 1) 4 times, \*(3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc, ch 1) in the next ch-3 sp, (3 dc in the next ch-1 sp, ch 1) 4 times\* Repeat from \* to \* 2 times, 3 dc in the same ch-3 sp as the first dc, ch 3; join with a sl st in the top of the beginning ch 3. (72 dc) Fasten off color B.

Round 7: Attach color A with a sc in any corner ch-3 sp, sc in the same ch-3 sp, sc in each of the next 3 dc, (sc in the next ch-1 sp, sc in each of the next 3 dc) 5 times, \*3 sc in the next ch-3 sp, sc in each of the next 3 dc, (sc in the next ch-1 sp, sc in each of the next 3 dc) 5 times\* Repeat from \* to \* 2 times, sc in the same ch-3 sp as the first sc; join with a sl st in the first sc. Fasten off. Weave in ends.

Back

With color A, ch 26

Row 1: Sc in the 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook and in each remaining ch across; ch 1, turn. (25 sc)

Row 2: Sc in the back loop only of the 1<sup>st</sup> sc, sc in the back loop only of each remaining sc across; ch 1, turn. (25 sc)

Row 3: Insert hook into the back loop only of the first sc and into the first unworked loop the row below and complete a sc, (insert hook into the back loop only of the next sc and into the next unworked loop the row below and complete a sc) 24 times; ch 1 tightly, turn. (25 sc)

Additional rows: Repeat row 16 until the piece measures about 7- 7 ½" long.

Last row: Insert hook into the both loops of the first sc and into the first unworked loop the row below and complete a sc, (insert hook into the both loops of the next sc and into the next unworked loop the row below and complete a sc) 13 times, work 15 sc around the bone ring, sc in the same st as the last sc on the potholder, (insert hook into the both loops of the next sc and into the next unworked loop the row below and complete a sc) 12 times. (26 sc) Do not fasten off. Pin granny square to piece. Sc evenly along the side of the back until you reach the granny square, then sc evenly through both layers (front & back) around 3 sides of the granny square, working extra sts in the corners as needed, sc evenly along the side of the back until you reach the top of the potholder; join with a sl st in the first sc. Fasten off. Weave in ends.
