

Mug-Hugger



MUG-HUGGER

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A coaster and insulator all in one!



Materials:

- About 2 ounces worsted weight cotton yarn
- Crochet hook size F (3.75 mm) or size needed to achieve gauge
- 3/4" flat button
- Sewing needle and thread

Gauge: Rounds 1-3 = 3 1/8"

***Pattern note:** Work tightly for best results. The "ch 2" at the end of rounds does not count as the first stitch on the next round.

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Mug-Hugger

Ch 5; join with a sl st in the first ch to form a ring.

Round 1: Ch 3 to count as the first dc, work 11 more dc in the ring; join with a sl st in the top of the beginning ch 3. (12 dc)

Round 2: Ch 3 to count as the first dc, dc in the same st as joining, work 2 dc in each of the 11 remaining dc around; join with a sl st in the top of the beginning ch 3. (24 dc)

Round 3: Ch 3 to count as the first dc, 2 dc in the next dc, (dc in the next dc, 2 dc in the next dc) 11 times; join with a sl st in the top of the beginning ch 3. (36 dc) Check gauge.

Round 4: Ch 3 to count as the first dc, dc in the next dc, 2 dc in the next dc, (dc in each of the next 2 dc, 2 dc in the next dc) 11 times; join with a sl st in the back loop only of the top of the beginning ch 3. (48 dc)

Round 5: Ch 3 to count as the first dc, dc in the back loop only of each dc around; join with a sl st in the top of the beginning ch 3; ch 2, turn. (48 dc)

Round 6: Bpdc in each dc around; join with a sl st in the top of the first bpdc; ch 2, turn. (48 bpdc)

Round 7: Fpdc in each of the first 46 sts; ch 2 turn without joining, leaving the last 2 sts unworked. (46 fpdc)

Round 8: Bpdc in each of the 46 sts; ch 2, turn. (46 bpdc)

Round 9: Fpdc in each of 46 sts; ch 12, turn. (46 fpdc & 12 ch's)

Round 10: Dc in the 6th ch from hook, dc in each of the next 6 ch's, bpdc in each of the next 46 sts; ch 1, turn. (46 bpdc & 7 dc)

Round 11: Fpdc in each of the first 46 sts; ch 2 turn, leaving the remaining 7 dc unworked. (46 fpdc)

Round 12: Repeat round 8.

Round 13: Fpdc in each of 46 sts; ch 2; join with a sl st in the first fpdc. Do not turn. (46 fpdc & 2 ch's)

Round 14: Sl st in each of the next 45 sts, sl st in each of the next 2 ch's; join with a sl st in the first sl st. Fasten off.

Coaster bottom

Ch 5; join with a sl st in the first ch to form a ring.

Rounds 1-3: Work the same as rounds 1-3 for the mug-hugger.

Round 4: Ch 3 to count as the first dc, dc in the next dc, 2 dc in the next dc, (dc in each of the next 2 dc, 2 dc in the next dc) 11 times; join with a sl st in the top of the beginning ch 3. (48 dc) Do not fasten off.

Finishing

Sl st both loops of round 4 of the coaster bottom to the unworked front loops on round 5 of the mug-hugger. Fasten off. Weave in ends. Insert a mug into the mug-hugger. Pull the strip formed with the 7 dc of round 10 through the handle. The chain loop at the end of the strip will be used for a button-

hole. Mark the button placement on the mug-hugger. Sew button in place.
