

# Cushioned Cotton Glasses Case



## CUSHIONED COTTON GLASSES CASE

Designed by Priscilla Hewitt  
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### Materials:

- About 1 1/2 ounces Sugar Babies 100% Cotton worsted weight yarn
- Crochet hook size F (3.75 mm)
- One 3/4" button

**Gauge:** Not important for this project. If you crochet loosely, use a size E hook.

**Finished size:** About 3" x 6 1/4"

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### *Case*

Ch 13.

**Round 1:** Sc in the 2nd ch from hook and in each of the next 11 ch's, working along the other side of the foundation ch, sc in each of the 12 ch's; join with a sl st in the first sc. (24 sc)

**Round 2:** Ch 3 to count as the first dc, dc in each of the remaining 23 sc around; join with a sl st in the top of the beginning ch 3. (24 dc)

**Round 3:** Sl st around the post of the first dc (actually the beginning ch 3) on round 2 inserting the hook from front to back

to front, ch 3 to count as the first fpdc, fpdc around the post of each of the remaining 23 dc; join with a sl st in the top of the beginning ch 3. (24 fpdc)

**Round 4:** Sl st around the post of the first fpdc (actually the beginning ch 3 on the previous round) inserting the hook from front to back to front, ch 3 to count as the first fpdc, fpdc around the post of each of the remaining 23 fpdc; join with a sl st in the top of the beginning ch 3. (24 fpdc)

**Additional rounds:** Repeat round 4 until the case is about 6 1/4" - 6 1/2" long.

### *Flap*

**Row 1:** Ch 1, sc in each of the first 12 fpdc; ch 1, turn. (12 sc)

**Row 2:** Sc in each sc across; ch 1, turn. (12 sc)

**Row 3:** Sc dec over the first 2 sc, sc in each of the next 8 sc, sc dec over the last 2 sc; ch 1, turn. (10 sc)

**Row 4:** Sc in each sc across; ch 1, turn. (10 sc)

**Row 5:** Sc dec over the first 2 sc, sc in each of the next 6 sc, sc dec over the last 2 sc; ch 1, turn. (8 sc)

**Row 6:** Sc in each sc across; ch 1, turn. (8 sc)

**Row 7:** Sc dec over the first 2 sc, sc in each of the next 4 sc, sc dec over the last 2 sc; ch 1, turn. (6 sc)

**Row 8:** Sc in each sc across; ch 1, turn. (6 sc)

**Row 9:** Sc dec over the first 2 sc, sc in each of the next 2 sc, sc dec over the last 2 sc; ch 1, turn. (4 sc)

**Row 10:** Sc in the first sc, ch 2, skip next 2 ch's for button-hole, sc in the last sc; ch 1, turn. (2 sc and 2 ch's)

**Row 11:** Sc dec over the first sc and the first ch, sc dec over the next ch and the last sc. (2 sts) Fasten off.

**Edging:** With right side of the flap facing you, attach yarn with a sl st in the end of the first row, (ch 1, sl st in the end of the next row) around. Fasten off. Weave in ends.

### *Finishing*

Insert glasses in case to mark where the button should be sewn. Sew button to case.
