

Super Slipper Socks

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Are you ready for February??? Crocheted in a wool blend yarn with a cushioned sole, these slipper socks are super snuggly!

Materials:

- 6 - 8 ounces Lion Brand Wool-Ease worsted weight yarn, depending on size of socks; a few yards of contrasting yarn for flower and leaves
- Crochet hook size G (4.00 mm) and H (5.00 mm) or size needed to achieve gauge
- Yarn needle
- Two 1" buttons for center of the flowers
- Sewing needle and thread

Gauge: Rounds 1-4 = about 3 3/4" across, from ch-2 sp to ch-2 sp

Finished size: Women's sizes small, medium, large

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Starting at the toe with size G hook and sock color yarn, ch 6

Round 1: Work 2 sc in the 2nd ch from hook, sc in each of the next 3 chs, 3 sc in the next ch, working along the base of the chs, sc in each of the next 3 chs, sc in the first ch; join with a sl st in the first ch, ch 1; turn. (12 sc)

Round 2: Sc in the first sc, 2 sc in the next sc, sc in each of the next 3 sc, 2 sc in the next sc, (sc, ch 2, sc) in the next sc, 2 sc in the next sc, sc in each of the next 3 sc, 2 sc the next sc, sc in the same st as the first sc; join with a hdc in the first sc to form the first ch-2 sp for the next round, ch 1; turn. (18 sc)

Round 3: Sc in the first ch-2 sp, sc in each of the next 9 sc, (sc, ch 2, sc) in the next ch-2 sp, sc in each of the next 9 sc, sc in the first ch-2 sp; join with a hdc in the first sc to form the first ch-2 sp for the next round, ch 1; turn. (22 sc)

Round 4: Sc in the first ch-2 sp, sc in each of the next 11 sc, (sc, ch 2, sc) in the next ch-2 sp, sc in each of the next 11 sc, sc in the first ch-2 sp; join with a hdc in the first sc to form the first ch-2 sp for the next round, ch 1; turn. (26 sc) Check gauge.

Round 5: Sc in the first ch-2 sp, sc in each of the next 13 sc, (sc, ch 2, sc) in the next ch-2 sp, sc in each of the next 13 sc, sc in the first ch-2 sp; join with a hdc in the first sc to form the first ch-2 sp for the next round, ch 1; turn. (30 sc)

Round 6: Sc in the first ch-2 sp, sc in each of the next 15 sc, (sc, ch 2, sc) in the next ch-2 sp, sc in each of the next 15 sc, sc

in the first ch-2 sp; join with a hdc in the first sc to form the first ch-2 sp for the next round, ch 1; turn. (34 sc)

Round 7: Sc in the first ch-2 sp, sc in each of the next 17 sc, sc in the next ch-2 sp, sc in each of the next 17 sc; join with a sl st in the first sc; turn. (36 sc)

Round 8: Ch 3 to count as the first dc, dc in each remaining sc around; join with a sl st in the top of the beginning ch 3. Do not turn. (36 dc)

Round 9: Ch 1 loosely, fpdc in each of the first 2 dc, bpdc in each of the next 2 dc, (fpdc in each of the next 2 dc, bpdc in each of the next 2 dc) 4 times, fpdc in each of the next 14 dc, bpdc in each of the last 2 dc; join with a sl st in the first fpdc. (36 sts)

Round 10: Ch 1 loosely, fpdc in each of the first 2 fpdc, bpdc in each of the next 2 bpdc, (fpdc in each of the next 2 fpdc, bpdc in each of the next 2 bpdc) 4 times, fpdc in each of the next 14 fpdc, bpdc in each of the last



2 bpd; join with a sl st in the first fpdc. (36 sts)

Rounds 11-22 (size small 5-6): (Repeat round 10) 12 times. Ch 1, turn at the end of round 22.

Rounds 11-24 (size medium 7-8): (Repeat round 10) 14 times. Ch 1, turn at the end of round 24.

Rounds 11-26 (size large 9-10): (Repeat round 10) 16 times. Ch 1, turn at the end of round 26.

Heel

Row 1: Sc in each of the first 18 sts, ch 1; turn. (18 sc)

Row 2: Sc dec over the first 2 sc, sc in each of the next 14 sc, sc dec over the last 2 sc, ch 1; turn. (16 sts)

Row 3: Sc dec over the first 2 sc, sc in each of the next 12 sc, sc dec over the last 2 sc, ch 1; turn. (14 sts)

Row 4: Sc dec over the first 2 sc, sc in each of the next 10 sc, sc dec over the last 2 sc, ch 1; turn. (12 sts)

Row 5: Sc dec over the first 2 sc, sc in each of the next 8 sc, sc dec over the last 2 sc, ch 1; turn. (10 sts)

Row 6: Sc dec over the first 2 sc, sc in each of the next 6 sc, sc dec over the last 2 sc, ch 1; turn. (8 sts)

Row 7: Sc dec over the first 2 sc, sc in each of the next 4 sc, sc dec over the last 2 sc, ch 1; turn. (6 sts)

Row 8: Sc dec over the first 2 sc, sc in each of the next 2 sc, sc dec over the last 2 sc, ch 1; turn. (4 sts)

Row 9: Sc dec over the first 2 sc, sc dec over the last 2 sc, ch 1; turn. (2 sts)

Row 10: Work 2 sc in each sc dec, ch 1; turn. (4 sc)

Row 11: Work 2 sc in the first sc, sc in each of the next 2 sc, 2 sc in the last sc, ch 1; turn. (6 sc)

Row 12: Work 2 sc in the first sc, sc in each of the next 4 sc, 2 sc in the last sc, ch 1; turn. (8 sc)

Row 13: Work 2 sc in the first sc, sc in each of the next 6 sc, 2 sc in the last sc, ch 1; turn. (10 sc)

Row 14: Work 2 sc in the first sc, sc in each of the next 8 sc, 2 sc in the last sc, ch 1; turn. (12 sc)

Row 15: Work 2 sc in the first sc, sc in each of the next 10 sc, 2 sc in the last sc, ch 1; turn. (14 sc)

Row 16: Work 2 sc in the first sc, sc in each of the next 12 sc, 2 sc in the last sc, ch 1; turn. (16 sc)

Row 17: Work 2 sc in the first sc, sc in each of the next 14 sc, 2 sc in the last sc; turn. (18 sc)

Ankle

Round 1: Ch 3 to count as the first dc, dc in each of the next 17 sc, fpdc in each of the next 2 fpdc on round 22 (24, 26), (bpdc in each of the next 2 bpdc, fpdc in each of the next 2 fpdc) 4 times; join with a sl st in the top of the beginning ch 3. (18 dc & 10 fpdc & 8 bpdc) Do not turn.

Round 2: Ch 1, bpdc in each of the first 2 dc, (fpdc in each of the next 2 dc, bpdc in each of the next 2 dc) 4 times, fpdc in each of the next 2 fpdc, (bpdc in each of the next 2 bpdc, fpdc in each of the next 2 fpdc) 4 times; join with a sl st in the top of the beginning ch 3. (18 fpdc & 18 bpdc)

Round 3: Ch 1, bpdc in each of the next 2 bpdc, (fpdc in each of the next 2 fpdc, bpdc in each of the next 2 bpdc) 17 times, fpdc in each of the last 2; join with a sl st in the top of the first bpdc. (18 bpdc & 18 fpdc)

Rounds 4-6: Repeat round 3. Change to size H hook after you've completed round 6.

Calf

Rounds 7-21: Using size H hook, repeat round 3.

Round 22: Ch 1, bpdc in each of the next 2 bpdc, (fpdc in each of the next 2 fpdc, bpdc in each of the next 2 bpdc) 17

times, fpdc in each of the last 2 fpdc; join with a sl st in the top of the first bpdc. (18 bpdc & 18 fpdc) Fasten off. Weave in ends.

Finishing: Thread yarn needle with yarn and sew closed the two seams in the heel of each stocking.

Flower

Using size G hook and flower color yarn, ch 5; join with a sl st in the first ch to form a ring.

Round 1: Ch 1, work 12 hdc in the ring; join with a sl st in the first hdc. (12 hdc)

Round 2: Ch 1, sc in the same st as joining, ch 3, skip next hdc, (sc in the next hdc, ch 3, skip next hdc) 5 times; join with a sl st in the first sc. (6 sc & 6 ch-3 sps)

Round 3: Ch 1, 5 dc in the next ch-3 sp, ch 1, (sl st in the next sc, ch 1, 5 dc in the next ch-3 sp, ch 1) 5 times; join with a sl st in the joining sl st. (30 dc & 12 ch-1 sps & 6 sl sts)

Leaves: Attach leaf color with a sl st through the two vertical bars on the back of any sc of round 2 of the flower, ch 5, sc in the 2nd ch from hook, hdc in the next ch, dc in each of the next 2 chs, sl st through the two vertical bars on the back of the same sc, ch 3, skip next (ch 1, 5 dc, ch 1), sl st through the two vertical bars on the back of the next sc of round 2 of the flower, ch 5, sc in the 2nd ch from hook, hdc in the next ch, dc

in each of the next 2 chs, sl st through the two vertical bars on the back of the same sc. Fasten off. Weave in ends.

Finishing: Position flower on the left side of one sock and another flower on the right side of the other sock. Place buttons over the center of the flowers and then sew in place with needle and thread.
